

#### FOR THOSE WHO MISS DIGGING IN THE DIRT...

#### The OREO Dirt Cake

1 large pkg of Oreo cookies

8 oz cream cheese

1 cup powdered sugar

4 Tbsp margarine or butter

2 small (3 1/2 oz) pkg instant vanilla pudding

4 cups of milk

12 oz Cool Whip

- Beat pudding and milk according to the package instructions until thick.
- Add the Cool Whip to the pudding and refrigerate.
- Blend the butter, cream cheese and sugar together and set aside.
- Crush Oreo cookies in a blender. (It works best if you crumble the cookies first before putting them in the blender).
- Mix 1/2 of the Oreo cookie crumbs with the cream cheese mixture and pudding mixture.
- Pour into an 8-inch flower pot, Yes. A real clay flower pot. (or bowl)
- Top the rest of the mixture in the bowl with the remaining cookie crumbs.
- Serve with a clean trowel (or spoon).



Serving ideas: Since the crushed Oreos look like real dirt you can put flowers in the "dirt" in the pot, rocks on the "dirt" in the pot or hide gummy worms in the "dirt cake." Use your imagination!
