

The Paria Plateau Vermillion Cliffs are the second "step" of the 5-step Grand Staircase of the Colorado Plateau. (Pg 8)

The Vermilion Cliffs are composed of the resistant red sandstone beds made up of deposited silt and desert dunes, cemented by infiltrated carbonates and intensely colored by red iron oxide and other minerals, particularly bluish manganese. (Wikipedia) (Diagram on page 8)

... but I discovered that there's even more to see just a bit south, in Arizona, right below the border.



Just west of Page, Az.




Colorado Plateau 4-state Map ↓

The Stairs ↓ (looking from south to the north)






Purple area is the 1 Grand Staircase


